

HOSPITAL RAINBOW

Name of Game: Hospital Rainbow

- Children with special needs, who are 6 years old and above, with at least moderate functioning and the ability to read.

By incorporating social stories, this game allows children with special needs to better prepare and manage the sensory information they may experience in a hospital environment.

1. To orientate children to commonly encountered procedures (i.e., height and weight taking, blood pressure (BP) taking and temperature measurement) when they are admitted to the hospital.

2. To prepare children for what they may see and possibly feel from the common procedures in the hospital.

3. To assess the children's familiarity with the steps and requisites involved in common procedures.

4. To incorporate social stories into the game play to prepare the child for common procedures in the hospital that may be otherwise unfamiliar or unexpected.

- Orientate player to height and weight taking procedure.
- Orientate patients to blood pressure (BP) and temperature taking procedure.
